Make and Use Visual Choice Cards

- Print each page on heavy cardstock (or print and laminate)
- 2. Cut apart the choice cards. Leave the storage page whole.
- 3. Add a Velcro dot to each circle on the storage page. Line up and then add the opposite Velcro dot to each matching choice card.
- Place the storage pages in a 3-ring binder.
- 5. Now you have an easy way to provide visual choices plus an easy way to store them!
